STATEMENTS OF FINANCIAL INTERESTS FILED BY CANDIDATES

To determine if a candidate has filed a Statement of Financial Interests go to <http://www.nadc.nebraska.gov> and do the following:

1. On the menu on the left click on View Campaign Filings
2. Click on Search
3. Type the last name of the candidate in the search box
4. Review the list of candidates and click on the name of the candidate you are seeking
5. From the list of filings, click on the latest filing date

Things to know about Statements of Financial Interests:

- Item 5 on the form shows the period covered.
- A candidate filing in December 2019 to appear on the 2020 ballot must file a Statement of Financial Interests covering 2018. Such candidates must file a new Statement of Financial Interests covering 2019 by March 2, 2020.
- A candidate filing in January 2020 or later to appear on the 2020 ballot must file a Statement of Financial Interests covering 2019.
- The information displayed on the website is not the complete statement on file.
