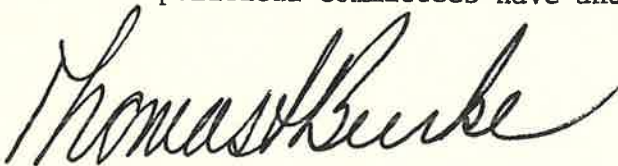


This Report to the Public contains information extracted from the disclosure reports filed by Political Action Committees in connection with the 1978 State of Nebraska Primary and General elections. Reported are the committee names, committee treasurers, and total committee contributions and expenditures. Listed also are the names of persons and organizations contributing over \$250 to each committee, and the actual amount of such contribution, as well as the names and organizations receiving financial support from the committee where such support exceeded \$250.

A political action committee is commonly referred to as a "PAC". While the term "PAC" is not defined in the law, it has come to mean a group which raises, receives, or spends political campaign funds and which has the following general characteristics:

1. Those who contribute to the PAC fund share a common interest which may be their occupation (e.g., teachers, farmers or doctors), their place of employment (e.g., insurance company or a savings and loan association), or their industry (e.g., petroleum, banking or construction). A PAC is often affiliated with a trade or professional association, draws its membership from the association, and is known as the political arm of the association. Contributions to a PAC usually come from the members of the group or association but may in some cases also come from unaffiliated individuals and organizations.
2. PAC campaign contributions are made to a number of candidates or issues, distinguishing PAC's from other political committees which are created to support or oppose a single candidate or single ballot issue.
3. A PAC is usually a continuing committee, organized not solely for a single election campaign but continuing its activity from election to election.
4. Contributions made by a PAC are not necessarily confined to candidates of a single political party. While a PAC may tend to favor one party's candidates more than those of another party, it remains a non-partisan organization and is therefore distinguishable from those political committees which are affiliated with a particular political party.

The Nebraska Accountability and Disclosure Commission files and maintains for public inspection the campaign statements of all political action committees. The Commission believes that this Report to the Public will assist citizens in becoming more knowledgeable as to the nature and extent of campaign financing in Nebraska. Similar reports on other forms of political committees have and will continue to be published.
