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PREFACE

In the 1978 and 1980 Primary and General Elections, a total of 102 candidates for the Nebraska Legislature raised over \$1,000 in support of their candidacy for office. This report identifies sources, by major category, of campaign receipts by these candidates.

Readers desiring information as to the names of the contributors and the amounts given by each contributor, how campaign funds were spent and for what purpose, or the sources of campaign loans, are encouraged to request copies of other Commission studies and reports listed below.

Also available for public inspection are the actual campaign reports filed by the candidates and their contributors. These reports can be examined at our office or at the office of the County Clerk (Election Commissioner) of the residence of the candidate.

The reader should be aware of a significant factor, not otherwise apparent which contributed to the overall increase in the category of business, union, trade and professional association contributions where comparison is made between 1978 and 1980. In 1978, contributions of the Nebraska Education Association to legislative candidates (\$30,094.01) were made through the association's political action committee and are, therefore, listed as PAC contributions in the 1978 portion of this report. In 1980, the Nebraska Education Association contributions to legislative candidates (\$48,380.92) were made directly from the association's general funds, and as such are listed under the business category in the 1980 portion of this report.
