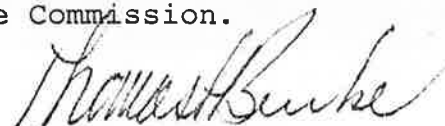

The candidate committees of incumbent elected public officials who are not up for reelection in 1980 are nonetheless required by the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act to file a Campaign Statement reporting their financial activity if the committee raised or spent in excess of \$1,000 from the closing date of the last Campaign Statement the committee filed with the Commission thru May 1, 1980.

Attached are summaries of the reports described above. Only those incumbents not up for reelection in 1980 and whose committees reported financial activity of \$1,000 or more during the reporting period are listed herein. Separate reports are issued which summarize the campaign financial activity of candidates in the 1980 primary and general elections. These reports are available free of charge from the offices of the Accountability and Disclosure Commission.
